Like me when we first met , he was my friend even though I was just a smart A#@ all the time , he knew it was just how I coped with my brother Danny’s death in Vietnam. He always had my back . He was just like that . He was a Brooklyn guy no doubt, but like Mr. Paul his dad , he was as kind and gentle a man as any youd want to know and he always cared about his family and friends no matter how good or bad things got. Loyal to the end .

When I was in the service he wrote me more than anyone from the neighborhood. That’s where we lost touch . I got a few more letters when I deployed in the early 1980s but that was it , life is like that sometimes. But back in 96 after I retired and came back to Brooklyn to work the garage , I was in the Tow Truck on McDonald Ave and Ave U And he saw the name on the door and ran off the sidewalk and opened the passenger door jumped In and gave me a hug and we went to eat at Enzo’s on the corner like I’d seen him the day before.

We kept up through the 90s but I sold the shop and moved to Florida. I found out after he was gone from one of the guys we knew in the neighborhood growing up . Paul I miss you , I wish we had more time together .

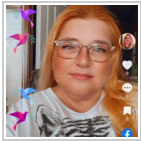
Paul , I bought a 65 Buick Wildcat last year , this time I looked at it through your eyes . Now It’s finished . the engine has all the chrome
